Earlier this year, a Business Recycling Survey was sent to businesses in Walpole to assess the current level of recycling at your business. Thank you to those who participated in this survey, as this provided an opportunity for businesses to identify materials that you would like to recycle, given the right opportunity.

Based on the survey responses received, a Request for Proposals (RFP) was written and publicized; inviting recycling companies to submit information about their services. We are pleased to announce that two recycling companies responded to this RFP, offering a choice of service providers for Walpole businesses interested in starting a recycling program or expanding their current program.

All of these vendors can help you create a convenient, cost-effective recycling program. Based on your business' needs, these vendors can help create partnerships with neighboring businesses to minimize program costs, and they can work with your current waste contractor to reduce waste costs and save money.

And for those businesses choosing to take advantage of this opportunity by participating in this Business Recycling Partnership, the Walpole Board of Health has three sizes of recycling containers available to loan (free of charge) on a first come first serve basis, with the start-up of recycling collection services. They have 7-gallon under desk bins, 23-gallon Slim Jim containers with slotted lids for paper recovery, and 95-gallon wheeled carts for consolidating larger quantities of materials.
