## What Are Waste Bans?

Waste bans are restrictions on the transfer and disposal of certain recyclable and hazardous items at waste facilities in Massachusetts (19 CMR 310.017).

*These bans are designed to:*

- ▶ Conserve diminishing landfill space
- ▶ Reduce the need for construction of new solid waste facilities
- ▶ Promote recycling efforts

Recycling at businesses can:

- **Be easy and economical** because businesses generate materials in large quantities and it's easy to keep these separate from the regular trash;
- **Prevent unnecessary disposal** of usable raw materials, save energy and reduce air and water pollution;
- **Reduce disposal costs**, businesses can save money by diverting materials from the trash dumpster to the recycling bin.

*Items banned from disposal facilities include:*

Mixed paper  
Household & large appliances  
Bottles and cans  
Computer monitors & TVs  
Cardboard  
Auto batteries  
Whole Tires  
Leaves & yard waste

## SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY



The sponsors of this recycling partnership have three sizes of recycling containers available to loan (free) to businesses on a first come first serve basis, with the start-up of recycling collection services.
